~ (1) קְדוּשַׁת בֵּית-הַכְּנֶטֶת ~ ~ The Holiness of the Synagogue (1) ~

One's conduct (behaviour) in a בֵּית-בְּנֶטֶת should be in keeping with its בְּרת-בְּנֶטֶת (holiness). A person should not behave in a disrespectful way or engage in casual talk.

Of course, we know that a person should avoid and keep far away from forbidden speech, such as gossip about others (לָשׁוֹן הָרַע) and quarreling. However, besides these types of speech being terrible sins in themselves, they are even worse when one is in a holy place because he is openly insulting the שְׁכִינָה (Hashem's Divine Presence).

A בּית-כְּנֶטֶת should only be used for studying תּוֹרָה and reciting prayers.
