Date palm branch: resembles the spine . The date has a good taste but no smell, so the lulov symbolizes the person who has Torah knowledge but not good deeds.	לוּלָב	_____
Citron : resembles the heart . The "Esrog" has both a pleasant taste and a pleasant smell, symbolizing one who possesses both knowledge of Torah and good deeds.	אֶתְרוֹג	_____
3 Myrtle branches: resemble the eyes . The "Hadas" has a pleasant smell only, and symbolizes the person who has good deeds but not Torah.	הַדָּסִים	_____
2 Willow branches: resemble the lips . The "Arovoh" has neither a pleasant taste nor a pleasant smell, and symbolizes the person who has neither Torah nor good deeds.	עֲרָבוֹת	_____
