<p>Shechem was visited by Avraham, Yaakov built a mizbeach to Hashem there, and Yosef's brothers were pasturing their father's sheep in Shechem when Yaakov sent Yosef to them.</p>	שְׁכָם T,A,M
<p>Mentioned as one of the cities in the portion of the Tribe of Dan (<i>Yehoshua 19:45</i>), Bnei Brak is famous in the Talmud as the location of Rabbi Akiva's court, and in the Pesach Haggadah as the site of the all-night Pesach Seder of Rabbi Akiva and the four other great rabbis.</p>	בְּנֵי בָּרָק T,A,M
<p>The Prophet Yonah hired a boat from Yafo to escape from Hashem's command to go to Nineveh. We read the Book of Yonah at the Mincha service of Yom Kippur.</p>	יָפוֹ T,A,M
<p>Jews began returning to Jaffa / Yafo in 1840. Many people came to live in the area, and this led to the establishment of Tel Aviv in 1908, which eventually became a major city of modern Israel.</p>	תֵּל אָבִיב M
<p>This ancient city is most famous as the place where the Sanhedrin sat at the time of the destruction of the Second Bet Hamikdash. One of the three requests made by Rabbi Yochanan ben Zakkai on the eve of that destruction was "spare me Yavneh and its Sages." (<i>Gittin 56b</i>)</p>	יָבֵנָה T,A,M
