When praying, one is standing in the presence of 'ה, the King of kings. A person must prepare himself for this meeting, as the נָבִיא (prophet), says: 'הָכּוֹן לִקְרַאת־אֱלֹקֶידְ יִשְׂרָאֵל" (עָמוֹס דִּיִּיב) ~

"Prepare yourself for your G-d, Israel." (Amos 4; 12)

Standing before Hashem requires preparation and careful thought. A person who is preparing to pray should feel as if he were going to meet a human king or an important government minister.
