A בֵּית-כְּנֶטֶת is a place that has been specially designed for prayer. Prayers recited there are of greater value than prayers recited in other places. Therefore, one should do his very best to pray in a בֵּית-כְּנֶטֶת, with a congregation.

Even if one can not find a מְלְיֵן (a group of ten men over 13 years of age) and has to pray alone, he should nevertheless pray in a בֵּית-בְּנֶטֶת. This is because it is a holy place, and prayers recited there are more acceptable to 'ה.
