SEDRA SUMMARY

At the beginning of this week's פָּרָשָׁה we see יְּתְרוֹ, the father-in-law of יִתְרוֹ, come to join the בְּנִי יִשְׂרָאֵל. He sent a message to מֹשֶׁה to let him know that he was on his way together with אַפּרָה s wife, אַפּרָה, and their two sons, אֲלִיעֶזֶר and יַּאֲלִיעֶזֶר.

משֶׁה came out to greet יְתְרוֹ . They asked each other about their welfare and discussed the wonderful things that ה' had done for יְתְרוֹ . בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל brought "עֹלֶה וּיְבָּחִים" - burnt offerings and other sacrifices to אַהְרֹן . ה' and all the elders of Israel came to share the meal with יִתְרוֹ , which he had prepared to celebrate his conversion to Judaism. ...but where was משֶׁה cites a מִשְׁה cites a מִשְׁה which explains that מִשְׁה was serving the guests. The greatest people take more pleasure in the comfort of others than their own.

A boundary was set up around the mountain. Nobody was permitted to climb the mountain or even touch its edge. On the third day the mountain was all in smoke because 'ה's presence was on it. The whole mountain trembled and there was the sound of the שׁוֹפַר. . .

Despite being the leader of all of בֵּנִי יִשְׂרָאֵל, chosen and appointed by 'ה, משה nevertheless accepts the advice of his father-in-law and appoints judges to help him judge and lead the people.

It is important to note that יְתָרוֹ does say that his advice should be acceptable to '7 (Rashi on Shemos 18:19). Therefore, the advice was given humbly and accepted humbly.

This is a great lesson for us. We should never reject advice because of who it is that is offering it. Good advice is worth listening to. We should also not be afraid to give advice because we feel we are not the right people to give it. There is no reason why we should not offer advice, as long as we do so in a respectful and humble way.
